The objects of the organization

Cocoa Bello is a non-profit, non-political and non-religious organization, with the purpose of developing and executing development projects within the agricultural sector in developing countries. Our work is characterized by close cooperation with national and international institutions and organizations within the sector referred to. By creating a foundation of members, constituted by experienced and competent personnel, the organization will develop and carry out qualitative projects on a non-profit basis.

The organization aims at integrating the principles of sustainable development with competitive production. By developing and executing projects with holistic perspectives the ambition is to contribute to regional development and international understanding and communication. A fundamental principle for the organization's efforts is that all projects after completion must be independent of the organization and conducted independently.

2005-2008 Strategy

In the subsequent 3-year-period the organization will focus on two interconnected projects, **Cocoa – from farming to retailing, a culture and knowledge exchange**, and **Fiji Chocolate Culture – a Swedish-Fijian community development project**. The projects demand great efforts before as well as during the execution, for which reason the organization has chosen to focus at one project at the time during the above mentioned period.
